



# How to Check the Version Number of GeoVision Software

## Summary

This technical notice introduces how to locate the version number of GeoVision software. For the officially released software, there are two ways of accessing its version number: one is from **VersionInfo.ini** file and the other is from **Windows Control Panel**. As for the patch file, you can only find its version number from the file name of the **VersionInfo.ini** file. The table below specifies the method for each software.

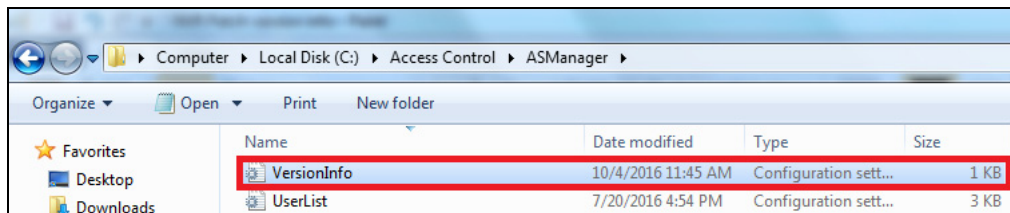
## Finding the Version Number of Your GeoVision Software

### For released software

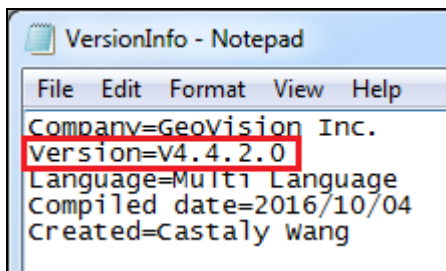
#### A. From VersionInfo.ini File

Take **GV-ASManager** for example.

- (1) In your GV-ASManager folder, select **VersionInfo.ini**.



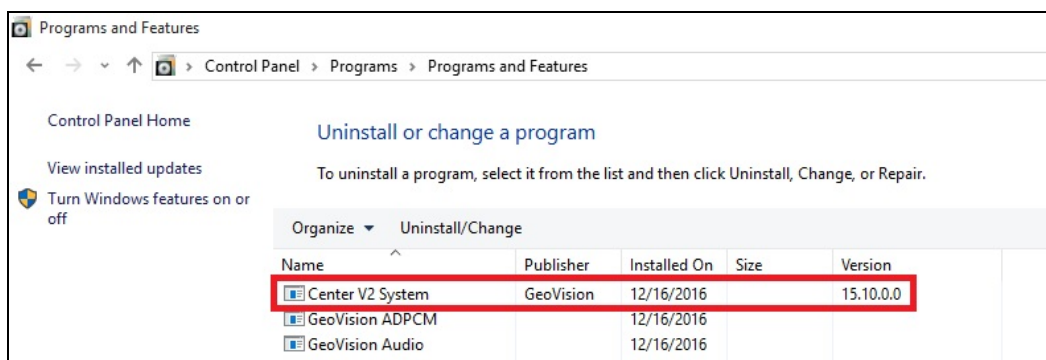
- (2) The version number of the software is listed in the notepad file.



#### B. From Windows Control Panel

Use **Center V2 System** as an example.

Go to **Control Panel**, select **Programs**, and click **Programs and Features**. You can see the version number of GV-Center V2.





## For Patch Files

Take **GV-NVR** for example. In your GV-NVR folder, the file name of VersionInfo.ini contains the version number of GV-NVR.
